Now Dinah the daughter of Leah, whom she had borne to Jacob. went out to visit the women of the region. ² When Shechem son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the region, saw her, he seized her and lay with her by force.³ And his soul was drawn to Dinah daughter of Jacob; he loved the girl, and spoke tenderly to her.⁴ So Shechem spoke to his father Hamor, saying, "Get me this girl to be my wife." ... ³⁰ Then Jacob said to Simeon and Levi, "You have brought trouble on me by making me odious to the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites and the Perizzites; my numbers are few, and if they gather themselves against me and attack me, I shall be destroyed, both I and my household." ³¹ But they said, "Should our sister be treated like a whore?"
