Iw Anthony, "Freedom in Community" Fourth in the series: "Your Faith Journey at Reservoir"

Scripture:

Ephesians 4:1-6, 15-16 (CEB)

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, as a prisoner for the Lord, I encourage you to live as people worthy of the call you received from God. <sup>2</sup> Conduct yourselves with all humility, gentleness, and patience.
