Scripture: Matthew 15:21-28 (NLT)

Try this: Spiritual Practice for Whole Life Flourishing

Read the scripture with an imaginative spirit this week.

Who are you in this story? The one wounded, oppressed and marginalized? The one who holds authority and power? The one who watches from the crowd?

Ask Jesus to direct your speaking up and/or your stepping back to listen, repent and aid in healing.

Read this poem this week: unharm someone by telling the truth you could not face when you struck instead of tended. - put the fire out (unburn) — Nayyirah Waheed, Salt. (2013)

Who have you harmed? Take steps to acknowledge, repent and aid in healing.
