





LUKE 1:28, 35-38, 46-55 FROM THE COMMON ENGLISH BIBLE ²⁸ When the angel came to Mary, he said, "Rejoice, favored one! The

Lord is with you!" ³⁵ The angel replied, "The Holy Spirit will come over you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore, the one who is to be born will be holy.
