



JOHN 15:1-5 NEW REVISED STANDARD VERSION

- ¹ "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinegrower.
- ² He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit.
- ³ You have already been cleansed by the word that I have spoken to you.

JOHN 15:1-5 NEW REVISED STANDARD VERSION

- ⁴Abide in me as I abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me.
