

God hear our prayer.

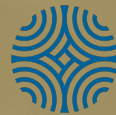
